Instructions for Club/Ministry of the year Award and Recognitions

- 1. Every club shall be governed by the rules and regulations established by the AY Department of the Gulf States Conference and the Camp Alamisco Directives. **No unregistered club members will be allowed**.
- 2. Participation can be established with two members if they are leading a club in their local church.
- 3. Each club must provide proof of a minimum of one meeting per month and at least 8 outreaches visit for 2024-2025 Year. (Outreach is ones a month with the MG club or any other club). Please look at YMMS reporting system.
- 4. All staff and staff over 18 years of age must have proof of the Sterling Volunteers Training and background check and CPR certification (for Invested MG's) before coming to camp. No CPR classes will be given in February, if you need the CPR certification, please email wvazquez17@gmail.com for further instructions to take it on your own.
- 5. Evidence of Work Plan for the year, 2024-2025 must be evidenced with Church Board Signature. (Area Coordinator should have received a copy, which they will submit to us via email).
- 6. All campers should have their Class A and B uniforms. (New club Exceptions should be communicated on time before Club Inspection at camp).
- 7. It is a MUST HAVE **Travel insurance for this event** and activities, especially Camporee 2025. Official documents will be requested on arrival at the gate/locating, no exceptions.
- 8. All under 18 years old must have the consent form singed by parents or legal guardian in front of the club director, or church Pastor. Medical Consent should address who is in charge of decision making in an adverse event or emergency situation arises.
- 9. Every club Director will have a **Row Call Card**, which should be given at check in. (please have it signed before leaving the event) This card should be turned in before the last event on Sunday, 8:00 AM.
- 10. Every Camp Site must be clean at all times. Trash thrown away before bedtime. NO EATING in tents is allowed. After you are dismissed, we expect that your area has been "Ant Operation Efficient." YOUR CLUB will receive a **BILL of \$50.00** if trash is found in your assigned area.

Camp-Cleaning Assignments

All Clubs- will receive at Directors meeting, a camp site area for cleaning and garbage disposal after Camporee is dismissed. Please be aware of this and communicate with club members. We will hand out the patches and pins after you return site inspection sheet signed by the camporee marshal.

Best Camping Club -Point System Table (Row Call Table). Look for table in the registration Package or ask your area Coordinator for details. You must get a Council Member or Coordinator to Sign the form at **each row call event**. (You could designate a timekeeper to keep card at all times).

Investiture Requirements and Evaluation Forms.

Candidates that the Area Coordinator has not evaluated will not get invested at camporee unless a previous arrangement has been made with Master Guide Coordinator. Thursday and Sabbath Events

Games are endurance and participation events. It is not a competition event. Your club will NOT be integrated with the other clubs. You need to be a team within your club. In a rare circumstance a team will be formed by participants with less than 5-7 members for participation purposes only. Some of these events are listed in the Gold Medallion requirements needed to complete your challenge.

Please ask at registration for the card with your name. See the list for the games on the MG website and download the instructions.

1. Campfire



Each participating group must make a bonfire and there will be a loop with a balloon with water which must burst with the heat of the campfire, the height will be considered for a small campfire. It will be counted by time. (Gold Medallion cards holders will need to complete this task to receive the approval to buy the Medallion). Materials will be provided.

2. Don't fall



This should be a flat board that must have several holes, this will be in pairs and each club must have at least 3 pairs for this activity. The purpose is for them to get from end A to end B without the ball falling down the sides or into the holes. Each club must make its own board measuring 1 foot wide by 3 feet long, the holes must be 1 inch in diameter. They will have 3 opportunities to complete this activity and if they do not pass it, they will be disqualified. Materials will be provided.

3. Basketball-

Everyone can participate. You will have three opportunities to complete it. If you have the Gold Medallion card, please make sure you have the card with your name, to complete the task. For this activity you can look at





the Gold Medallion instructive for the instructions for girls and boys. Materials will be provided.


4. Hula Hoop

The purpose of this activity is that the whole club with a hula hoop passes it from one end to the other



without disconnecting at any time from each other, otherwise the penalty will be that they start the hula hoop again from the beginning of the line, they will have 3 opportunities to be able to carry out this activity, if they do not complete it they will be disqualified. Need to bring enough hula hoops for the participants.

5. .Bandages









They must make diverse types of bandages, each team must demonstrate their skills when helping someone, they will be given the list of the types of bandages they must make at the time, based on the list of bandages that we send for them to practice. There will be a time limit to conduct this activity. The Instructor of the Game will be the timekeeper. Each club must bring its own bandages or material to make the bandages, (scarves, bandages, splints, etc.)

6. Moorings



Each team must prepare with different ties to be able to make a table with their wooden chairs or whether it is a chair, if it is the table it has to be with their chairs and the team must assemble it correctly and, in the end, they must test their creation and they must sit down to rate their work themselves. If it is a chair, there must be at least 3 participants per group, 3 groups per club. And in the same way, when they finish assembling, they will have to sit down. The type of mooring will be checked, and each one must know the name of the type of mooring they will be performing. (Each club must bring its materials to put together what they have to present. The size must be proportional to what they can easily move for the place of the event since at the end they will have to collect their materials.

7. Types of stretchers



Each group must perform diverse types of bedding, at least 5 to move on to the next level, the type of stretcher they will be making will be inspected in detail. **Each group must bring** what they need for their activity.

8. Set up tents



Each group will have to set up a tent in the right way, they will be uncommon types of tents, or they will even be asked to make a shelter. The tents will be provided for the group so that they can assemble what is provided to them and it will be with a time limit. At the end, it will be verified that it has been put together correctly. Material will be provided.

9. Bucket fall



In this challenge there must be at least 5 participants per group, the purpose is that as a team they lift a 5-gallon container full of water as shown in images and remove their shoes and socks without spilling the water, in case they spill it they will have three opportunities and a maximum time. If they do not complete the challenge before the end of their time, they must leave the game. Need to bring buckets for participants.

10. Ribbed



This activity is a little different from what we are used to, there must be 4 people per team, they must be in a giant **sack that will be provided**, this is teamwork, and they must get from one end to the other in a maximum time. Participants must work completely as a team to be able to jump evenly so that they can move forward in an efficient manner. Materials will be provided.

11. Balloon Toss





Sabbath- Bible Rally- color coded cards (if participating in the gold medallion take cards with you)

12. Jigsaw Puzzle (Saturday Afternoon)

A puzzle will be made with some letters that are difficult to assemble or a figure, the group will have a maximum time to assemble. Material will be provided.



13. 28 Beliefs (Saturday Afternoon)

Each team will receive the 28 beliefs in the form of drawings, and key words in no specific order, and each team must order the 28 beliefs correctly, the number of correct answers they have in the time they will be given will be scored.

14. Traffic light code (Saturday afternoon)



They must complete some sentences that they will be asked to do, this activity will be supporting the 28 beliefs in which they will be working, everything will be in a simultaneous way, it will be part of a biblical rally and they will have to be attentive to the indications that will be given to them about what they have to transmit (it is recommended that they practice a lot about the signs and their correct use, since the progress and fulfillment of this activity depends on this. (Gold Medallion cards holders will need to complete this task to receive the approval to buy the Medallion). Wiki site. It is expected that every club brings their own emergency kit and in case great intervention is required, an EMS service will be activated. All expenses will be overseen as recommended by the protocol established by the GSC and the Youth Department.
